ANGLICANISM IS... SACRAMENTAL IN PERSPECTIVE

- Preserves mystery in our faith tradition
- Sacramental Perspective all of life is sacred
- Sacraments "real presence" (wide range); outward and visible signs of inward and spiritual grace
 - Avoids extreme rationalism and mere symbolism
- Values contemplative spirituality (intuitive vs. cognitive) and Charismatic expression

 - 2. Announcement of Grace—God's promise to pardon & forgive
 - 3. Exercise of Faith—believing, trusting, thanking & praising

- Calendar (691) Red Letter; Optional Anglican; Ecumenical
- Sunday, Holy Day, & Commemoration Lectionary (716)
 - Years A, B, C (determined: divisible by 3. 2019 = Year ___)
- Daily Office Lectionary (734; 1 or 2-Year Cycle)
 - OT yearly; NT mostly twice/year; Psalms 30 or 60 days
